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Subject: Federal Grant Award Period of Performance

The policy of the Department of Human Services (DHS) is to comply with Period of Performance requirements (2 CFR 200.309) under the Post Federal Award Requirements as stated in the Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards.

DHS shall charge Federal awards only with allowable costs during the period of performance as specified in each award’s terms and conditions. This policy also holds true for all sub-recipients of DHS federal awards.
